

SGA Highlights

1 Diversified Cultural Exchange and Experience

Students can experience traditional Chinese culture, such as calligraphy, tea ceremony, and paper-cutting, visit cultural sites, and explore the specialties of Chengdu, such as Sichuan Opera face-changing and Sichuan cuisine.

2 Academic exchanges in the field of finance and economics

Through lectures taught by the faculty of Southwestern University of Finance and Economics, as well as visits to the Finance and Economics Laboratory and the Center for Financial Innovation.

Academic Experience

The academic experience within SGA at SWUFE features specialized lectures conducted by experienced faculty on critical topics such as the Chinese economy, new forms of productivity, China's financial markets, and the Belt and Road Initiative. Participants gain insights through these lectures and by visiting the university's advanced financial laboratories and innovation centers, combining theoretical knowledge with practical applications. 


- Founded in 1925 in Shanghai as Kwang Hwua University
